BID 26-050, WABASH RESOURCE CENTER BASKETBALL COURT AND SIDEWALK ADDENDUM #1

- Q1: Is this project subject to the Davis-Bacon Act or just Davis-Bacon related?
A1: This project is subject to the Davis-Bacon Act.
- Q2: Please provide clarity on the hourly rates required.
A2: The Wage Decisions provided in the HUD Packet are the only ones that will apply for the duration of the project. Executive Order 14026 found on page 1 of the Wage Decision table applies to this project. It states that the contractor must pay all covered works at least \$17.75 per hour unless the applicable wage rate determined is higher. Rates with the asterisks besides them are entitled to the wage as set by Executive Order 14026.
- Q3: Is this project Davis Bacon Related Act or Davis Bacon Act? The difference is if it is Davis Bacon Act Related then the \$ 17.75 minimum wage will not apply. If David Bacon Act Related the wages for a general laborer of \$ 11.96 will apply on the FL20250223 attached in the bid documents. I suspect it is Davis Bacon Act Related as most LAP and CDBG projects are. Please confirm, the bid cost will be more if a general laborer is \$ 17.75 per hour. We just want all bidders to figure the same cost while building a crew cost.
A3: Please see A1 and A2 above.
- Q4: FRC is shown on page C-02 of the plans is .75 # or 1.5 # per cubic yard required?
A4: 1.5 lbs. per cubic yard.
- Q5: Is the 6' chain link required to be vinyl coated?
A5: Yes. More information is available in section 32 31 13 of Attachment D - Project Manual now available on the County's FTP site. To receive a copy of Attachment D, please go the following FTP site: <https://ftp3.polk-county.net>, you will be prompted for a User ID and Password. The User ID is procurevondor and the password is solicitation. After you have logged in to the FTP site, double click on the file folder "BID 26-050, Wabash Resource Center Basketball Court and Sidewalk_addendum 1.zip", select "Open" or "Save As" to download.
- Q6: The attached bid sheet line item # 12 and # 14 I think should be removed since the 19" x 30" pipe and MES are not shown on the plans. Please confirm.
A6: There is not a 19" x 30" pipe. See 'Bid 26-050 Bid Sheet revised' which can be downloaded following the instructions in A5 above.
- Q7: Line item # 4 on the bid sheet says includes removal of sidewalk I don't see any on the demo plan sheet C-03 that needs to be removed please confirm.
A7: There are no sidewalks to be removed. See 'Bid 26-050 Bid Sheet revised' which can be downloaded following the instructions in A5 above.
- Q8: Bid sheet shows 1400 CY of Embankment is that correct? If so, can you please provide cross-section of where the fill is needed.

- A8: The Bid 26-050 Bid Sheet revised shows Embankment now to be a lump sum item. 1400 cy was calculated by the EOR, however does not include shrinkage and fluff which is now tabulated as lump sum.
- Q9: Will the County provide the basketball goals and equipment materials for the contractor to install only? If not, please provide what is required to purchase.
- A9: The contractor is to provide the basketball goals. The backboard manufacturer is Jaypro Sports and the model is ALB-24BT with Jaypro Sports goal model GBA-342A. The basketball goal manufacturer is WAUSAU TILE model TF7175 concrete basketball standard.
- Q10: The 5' landscape buffer requires 10-canopy trees, 19-under story trees and 115 shrubs on plan sheet C-04. Can a pay item be added to the bid sheet for these items?
- A10: Due to the numbers of trees on the site, we have a waiver from the County to any additional landscaping. Please see Attachment E – Waiver available on the County's FTP site which can be downloaded following the instructions in A5 above.
- Q11: Will the wooden tree protection on plan sheet C-04 be required to be constructed? If they are required, please confirm how many are to be built.
- A11: No, there is no work proposed in or around the 5 ft. landscape buffer, so tree protection requirements described on plan sheet C-04 may be disregarded.
- Q12: How tall is the chainlink fence?
- A12: 6 Feet.
- Q13: What color is the chainlink fence?
- A13: Please see section 32 31 13 of Attachment D - Project Manual now available on the County's FTP site which can be downloaded following the instructions in A5 above.
- Q14: How many gates, and how wide and tall do you want the chainlink fence gates?
- A14: There are 3 openings 4ft wide. More information is available in 'Bid 26-050 Bid Sheet revised' which can be downloaded following the instructions in A5 above.
- Q15: Is the chainlink fence just along the perimeter of the basketball court or anywhere else? Is this core drilled into the court, or will it be in the grass around the perimeter of the court? I see a double gate. Will the basketball court have (1) single gate and (1) double gate?
- A15: Construction Plan sheet C-04 shows the fencing near the perimeter of the park on the East, South, and West boundaries. There is one gate on the south line and two in the West line. Fencing is not surrounding just the basketball court but surrounding entire project limits.
- Q16: The plans indicate 368 linear feet for the basketball court fence, while the spreadsheet mentions 960 linear feet. Is there another basketball court in addition to this one?
- A16: See sheet C-04. Fencing location surrounds entire project boundary not just the basketball court.
- Q17: In the bid spreadsheet, under clearing and grubbing, it states that the removal of existing sidewalk is included; however, there is no sidewalk removal indicated in the plans. Please confirm whether sidewalk removal is part of the scope of work.

A17: No sidewalks will need to be removed. See 'Bid 26-050 Bid Sheet revised' which can be downloaded following the instructions in A5 above.
