Q1: Is there a pre-bid meeting?

A1: No, there is no pre-bid meeting.

Q2: What is the substantial/final completion time?

A2: This bid is not for a specific project. Work orders will be issued as projects are assigned.

Q3: Is there a bid bond required?

A3: No.

Q4: Are there any other bid documents?

A4: No.

Q5: Is there a plan holders list?

A5: No.

Q6: Can the owner provide detailed, itemized bid tabs for this or similar past bid projects?

A6: Yes, bid analysis from the last bid. See attached Exhibit "A"

Q7: Will more than one contractor be awarded contracts, or just low bidder?

A7: In accordance with Special Conditions, page 35: Award will be made to all responsive, responsible bidders meeting qualifications.

Q8: Will there be any liquidated damages associated with this contract?

A8: No.

Q9: Can the County confirm how pricing adjustments will be handled over the contract term (CPI or other escalation mechanisms)?

A9: In accordance with General Information, page 20: Item #20 Price Increases: The Procurement Director reserves the right to increase/decrease price after the bid has been in place for a minimum of 12 months, when it is in the best interest of the County. Increases/decreases will be determined by the Consumer Price Index (CPI-U).

Q10: Will there be any retainage withheld during progress payments?

A10: No.

Q11: Is a Certificate of Insurance needed reflecting the Owners as a policy holder due at the time of bid submittal.?

A11: No. A Certificate of Insurance is only required from the successful bidder(s) at the time of award. See page 31 Insurance Requirements.

Q12: Provide the budget for this project?

A12: There is no budget, this bid is not for a project, it will be used as needed when projects come up. The Roads & Drainage Division budgets \$5 million annually for drainage repairs, however, the County does not guarantee a minimum/maximum spend.

Q13: Do you have Union Requirements?

A13: No.

Q14: Do you have maps/plans, to see exactly what location within Polk County the lining is to take place, available?

A14: This bid is not for a specific project. Work orders will be issued as projects are assigned.

Q15: Can I get a copy of any addendums that have been released to date?
