Bid 26-148 – Commercial Irrigation and Repairs

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Questions and Answers

Question 1: Where the bidding entity is part of a family of affiliated companies under common ownership and management, must the two-year FEIN history and the three commercial references be exclusively in the bidding entity's own name, or will the County accept time in business and/or references for similar services performed by the bidder's affiliated companies or their principals?

Answer 1: The County may consider business history and references from affiliated companies when such companies are under common ownership and engaged in the same or substantially similar line of work as the bidding entity. The bidder shall clearly identify the relationship between the entities and provide sufficient documentation demonstrating common ownership. The reference must be from the prime vendor submitting the bid.

Question 2: Special Condition 4 provides that the work "shall be performed by the entity submitting the bid." Please confirm whether the awarded vendor may use labor furnished by an affiliated company or subcontractor working under the awarded vendor's direct supervision and quality control, with all E-Verify, insurance, and safety requirements satisfied. If not, please confirm whether leased or co-employed workers operating under the vendor's exclusive direction are considered the vendor's own workforce for purposes of this condition.

Answer 2: Subcontractors and leased or co-employed workers are not permitted on this bid.

Question 3: I would like to request copies of any available records related to the previous contract for these services, including:

- Prior contract agreement(s)
- Prior awarded vendor(s)
- Bid tabulation(s) and pricing sheets
- Award recommendation and approval documents
- Previous contract amount(s) and term(s)
- Any amendments, renewals, or extensions associated with the prior contract
- Current or previous scope of work documents for comparison purposes

If the previous contract was issued under a different bid number or title, I would appreciate receiving the records for the most recent substantially similar irrigation repair and maintenance contract.

Answer 3: This was initially posted under Bid 24-482, Non-Potable Well and Commercial Irrigation Repair, however no bids were received.
