

RESOLUTION NO.: 26-117

**RESOLUTION STATING THAT THERE ARE NO COUNTY-OWNED PROPERTIES
DEEMED APPROPRIATE FOR AFFORDABLE HOUSING**

WHEREAS, pursuant to *Florida Statutes 125.379*, by October 1, 2023, and every 3 years thereafter, the county shall prepare an inventory list of all real property within its jurisdiction to which the county or any dependent special district within its boundaries holds fee simple title which is appropriate for use as affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, properties which are identified as appropriate for use as affordable housing in the inventory list may be: 1) used for affordable housing through a long-term land lease requiring the development and maintenance of affordable housing, 2) offered for sale and the proceeds used to purchase land for the development of affordable housing or to increase the local government fund earmarked for affordable housing, 3) sold with a restriction that requires the development of the property as permanent affordable housing, 4) donated to a nonprofit housing organization for the construction of permanent affordable housing, or 5) otherwise made available by the county or special district for use for the production and preservation of permanent affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, Polk County has reviewed its current inventory of County-owned properties and has identified no properties which it deems to be appropriate for affordable housing; and

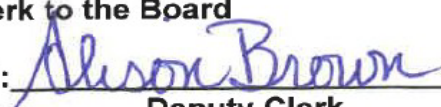
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF POLK COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN REGULAR MEETING ASSEMBLED THIS 15TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2026;

1. The Board hereby approves this resolution stating that there are no properties, as of the date of this resolution, owned by Polk County or any dependent special district within its boundaries, which the Board deems as appropriate for affordable housing.

2. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
